Rules & Guidelines

- 1. Entry is free of charge and open to the public (there is no age restriction but the youth are encouraged to participate).
- 2. There are no geographical or national restrictions for participants in the competition.
- 3. One entrant may submit maximum two videos for each section in the competition.
- 4. Optimize your video entirely in landscape mode (horizontal video is a must for entering the competition).
- 5. The submitted clips must be 60-120 seconds long. Submissions exceeding 120 seconds might be disqualified.
- 6. Videos must be submitted as one single file in the highest quality (720 res, MP4, no more than 50 MB).
- 7. For videos in non-English language, an English transcription of conversation is required.
- 8. Submit your video along with registration form at <a href="mailto:mai
- 9. The copyright of the materials submitted for this competition remains with respective participants. However, each entrant grants APSCO and ISA the right to use the submitted materials in its communication crediting the copyright owners.
- 10. Submission of an entry shall be taken to mean acceptance of the Competition rules and the Terms and Conditions.
- 11. Entries whose material will be chosen by the Selection Board, receive a certificate of participation
